

MyRepublic Rocket Cup® Overwatch - Terms and Conditions

Please read these Terms and Conditions completely before signing up to play in the Rocket Cup (hereinafter referred to as “the Tournament”). This Agreement documents the legally binding terms and conditions attached to participation in the Tournament.

1. Standard terms

By signing up for and playing in this Tournament, you accept and agree to be bound by the terms and provisions of this agreement and subject to the official rules of the Tournament, available here[link]. Acceptance of this agreement is required to participate in the Tournament.

The Tournament and all original content, features, and functionality related to the Tournament are operated by the organisation Amateur Oceanic Esports (“AOEsports”).

2. Privacy

Any information provided by entrants to this Tournament may be displayed publicly for the purposes of the Tournament, and kept by AOEsports as record.

3. Who can enter

Any person residing in Oceania who is 13 years or older may enter this Tournament. Anyone under the age of 13 must acquire consent from their parent or guardian in order to participate in the Tournament. Anyone under the age of 13 who has not received consent will be disqualified from the Tournament, and will not receive any prizes.

4. How to enter

The Tournament will be played on Sunday, 23rd of February 2020, between the hours of 5pm AEDT, and 12am AEDT. In order to enter participants must complete the registration form on the AOEsports website between the opening of signups on Sunday, 16th of February 2020 and Thursday, 20th of February 2020. Entrants must provide their full Discord username; full Overwatch account name and further details about their Overwatch account.

Any registration in the Tournament may be terminated by AOEsports for any abuse, cheating or breakage of the official rules of the Tournament, which will result in the forfeiture of all participation in the Tournament. Additionally, users may withdraw from the Tournament at any time by contacting a member of AOEsports staff on the official AOEsports Discord server, or by emailing contact@aoesports.com.au.

Four additional prizes will be awarded to other individual players for exceptional performance during the Tournament. These prizes will only be awarded to customers of MyRepublic Pty Ltd. Prizes will be sent to players within three weeks of the completion of the Tournament.

7. Right to change terms and conditions

AOEsports reserves the right to change these conditions from time to time as it sees fit and your continued participation in the Tournament will signify your acceptance of any adjustment to these terms. You are therefore advised to re-read this statement on a regular basis.

8. Liability

In the case of the intervention of any outside act, agent or event which prevents or significantly hinders AOEsports's ability to proceed with the Tournament on the dates and in the manner described in these terms and conditions, including but not limited to vandalism, power failures, tempests, natural disasters, acts of God, civil unrest, strike, war, act of terrorism, AOEsports may in its absolute discretion cancel the Tournament. They may decide to restart it from the start in the same conditions.

If, for any reason, this competition is not capable of being conducted as planned, including, but not limited, due to tampering, unauthorised intervention, fraud, technical failures or any other causes beyond the control of AOEsports which corrupt or affect the administration security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of this competition, AOEsports reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to disqualify any individual who tampers with the entry process, take any action that may be available, and to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Tournament.
